## Trillium Creek Primary School PTA General Meeting

January 11, 2023, 9:00 AM | Meeting called by Samantha Barr

## Call to Order

- Principal and Staff Report Kate Donegan
  - School Improvement Plan was presented by Kate
  - Bringing back enrichment classes
  - o Science Fair
  - Trillium Creek Work Plan 22/23
    - o Goal: Bridget community of parents and school community building.
    - School Vision: create a culture of excellence and equity within a community of care.
    - o School board goals, district goals along with our own school's goals:
    - o 4 goals:
    - o Belief/belonging
    - o Primary Day
    - o Math (recovery from covid)
    - Literacy (recovery from covid)
    - o Trillium Specific:
      - 462 students (last springs numbers)
      - 27% of students do not identify their race as white
      - 29% of students do not identify their race as white (the goal is to have the staff match the student population)
      - 3% of staff are emerging English speakers
      - 10% of students experience a disability (have an IEP)
      - 6.5% of students experience socioeconomic disadvantage.
- Discussion with PTA Members about open boundaries for our school... released yesterday
  that all primary schools in the district are now open... but that isn't free for all. Rules still
  apply.
- Each year is unique with class sizes and teachers and students fluctuating.

- Back to report:
  - State Assessment Data
  - ELA (English Language Arts) 73% State average 44% (I believe) (5 pt drop since Covid)
  - Math- 64% State average is 36% (Also 5 pt. drop since Covid)
  - Grade 3-5 students were surveyed to see what their perception is of school and how the school can improve.
  - Students reported that Teacher Student relations hips 81% favorable (80-99% percentile) Up 2 points
  - Sense of belonging 75% (80-99th% percentile) up 9 points
  - School Climate 72%
  - Trillium does well nationally, so they always compare themselves to make sure they are improving to support the students and the school.
  - PLT- Professional Learning Team (The team who helps support the teacher...
     like the 3rd-grade teachers and staff that work with the 3rd graders)
  - We have an equity/steering committee so anytime our school wants to implement something, the committee reviews it to make sure it is equitable.
     Look at Zones of Regulation, implemented school-wide and is consistent school-wide. Targeted because kids identified with this.
  - Belief and Belonging Including family and other school activities... like the PTA!
  - This year they revised the Pillars of Character
  - Literacy -Uses reading assessment now used district-wide. Helping teacher teams using the info and teaching each kid more.
  - Math uses teams and data to help students using pre-assessments to see how to help each student.
  - Creating a culture of excellence and equity within a community of care!
  - o KATE LOVES QUESTIONS! So ask her!
  - Question: Are we still behind? Yes, but they are using their regular curriculum to get kids caught up.
  - Writing is included in ELA.
